FESTIVAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Incomplete applications will be returned with payment. The CSMA has the right to approve or deny any application.

The application deadline is **Friday, April 9, 2010 at 5:00PM**. Applications submitted after April 9, 2010 must include a late fee of \$75.00. **No applications will be accepted after Friday, April 16, 2010 at 5:00PM. There is no exception to this rule.**

Applications and payment must be delivered to **BULI CAFÉ** (on Cedar Springs) with correct payment. Payment must be a money order or check, no cash or credit cards will be accepted. To ensure correct processing, please put the application and payment in an envelope and drop in the **CSMA Art Festival drop box inside of BULI**. Do not mail or fax application.

SET-UP INFORMATION

The 3900 block of Cedar Springs will be closed from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM on the day of the festival. Set-up time starts at 8:00 AM. All artist / vendors must be checked in with a festival coordinator no later than 9:00 AM. **All artist / vendors must be in their space and fully set-up by 9:45AM. There are no exceptions.**

STRIKE INFORMATION

Tear down will begin at 7:00 PM (the close of the festival) and all artist / vendors must be cleared of their space no later than 9:00 PM. The City of Dallas special event permit states that the street must be opened at 10:00 PM.

LOADING AND UNLOADING

Due to the space limitations within the barricaded section of the Cedar Springs, there will be no vehicles allowed inside the barricades (including set-up and strike.) You may access the local parking lots to unload and load. Please do not block any traffic. The CSMA is not responsible for any parking violations.

FAMILY FRIENDLY FESTIVAL

The Cedar Springs Art Festival is family friendly festival for the community. Please be respectful of the community. Please do not display artwork that is vulgar or of a sexual nature.

ELECTRICITY POLICY

If you purchase the electrical outlet option on the application, this is just the access to an electrical outlet. You must provide any and all extension cords and power strips. The CSMA is not responsible for any damage due to electrical extension cords, etc.

TENT INFORMATION

If you supply your own tent, please remember that may need to be weighted due to the weather. Please make arrangements. The CSMA is not responsible for any damages that your tent causes to you or others. If you choose to tent option on the application, that tent will be weighted upon set-up.

WEATHER POLICY

In the event of extreme weather, including but not limited to rain, the CSMA reserves the right to cancel the festival. In the event of a cancellation, festival fees will not be refunded.
